APPLYING TO WHAT MOVES YOU

 We would be happy to welcome you in Berlin as a participant of **WHAT MOVES YOU**. Before you apply, we recommend that you **familiarize yourself with the information below**. These are the steps that must be completed for your application:

1. Fill in the **application form** completely. You will find the form on pages 5-10 of this Application Package. **Note:** Participation/Application under 18 years of age is possible only with consent of your legal guardian/parents. This applies also to those who will be 18 years of age when project starts.
2. **Send in the form** by no later than **30 April 2014** (no fax or e-mail applications accepted).
3. Your application is valid only with **payment of the registration fee of € 25,00**. This fee should be credited to our account no later than 10 days after receipt of your application documents in order to preserve the date of receipt of your application, otherwise this is shifting to the number of days that the fee is received late.
4. You will receive a **confirmation** about your application after the fee has been paid.
5. A **status report** shows, whether your application is accepted, declined or wait-listed due to already fully occupied number of places. You will receive your status report **within 60 days of confirmed application**.
6. Accepted applicants will receive an **acceptance agreement** as soon as possible, but **no later than 15 May 2014**.
7. If you have received your acceptance agreement, the full **participation fee of € 800,00** has to be paid no later than **31 May 2014**.
8. **Candidates wait-listed** may fill places becoming vacant if another participant has resigned. In such a case, the participation fee has to be transferred within 14 days.

WMY PROGRAM INFORMATION

Participants will work in groups on Antonin Dvorak's 9th Symphony „From The New World“ and other works in Speech Eurythmy (texts, poems, etc.), which will be performed at the end of the 4 project weeks. Aside from the Eurythmy rehearsals there will be a program offering artistic courses (drawing, singing), workshops (Anthroposophy, philosophy, history) and guided historical tours of Berlin and surroundings.

Timetable: In the first three weeks there will be about five hours eurythmy rehearsals daily in four separate groups. Workshops will be on offer several times per week. In the final week are the rehearsals with orchestra and at least two performances. For more details about the project please check our website. If you should have any further questions regarding your application, please do not hesitate to call or write.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

TERMS AND CONODITIONS FOR WHAT MOVES YOU

Participants of **WHAT MOVES YOU** must be 17 years of age and may not be older than 23 years old when project starts/ends. Underage applicants and/or -participants will need the consent of their legal guardian/parents (these are liable for the applicant/participant). Previous knowledge in the field of Eurythmy is mandatory (Waldorf student or other). There is no participation for trained eurythmists, eurythmy students or those connected to a eurythmy training. For participation, a healthy condition is necessary. You should be

able to communicate at least in English and/or German. Participation is only for the entire project period, which runs from 13 July 2014 (4:00 PM) to 11 August 2014 (1:00 PM).

About participation will be decided upon personal application. Application procedure starts 15 October 2013 and ends 31 March 2014. All applications will be processed on first-come first-served basis. There are 80 places available, any further applications will be set on a waiting list to move up after cancellations. WMY reserves the right to withdraw the course if the number of participants is not sufficient, or if the financial resources needed for running the program are not secured, by 15 April 2014. Fees and costs will be refunded in full if WMY cancels the course. In case of cancellation, you will be notified by 15 April 2014. There is no legal entitlement on participation.

RULES WHEN IN BERLIN

1. The participation in all Eurythmy rehearsals is obligatory, workshops (and other choices) are optional.
2. School rules and regulations of the *Rudolf Steiner School Berlin* apply (downloadable at WMY's website).
3. Consuming alcohol and drugs is prohibited.
4. Minor participants must remain on project campus (school grounds) from 11:00 PM to 07:00 AM.
5. We do not accept any liability for loss or damage of your private belongings.
6. The organizer has permit to release photographs and filming in media issues related to the project, showing the participants. If you do not agree to this permission, please state in Application Form below.
7. Anyone who fails to comply with these rules may be disqualified by the organizers. There is no refunding of participation fee in such cases. Additional costs may apply to minors returned home (or their parents).

FEES & COST POLICIES

APPLICATION FEE

The registration fee for WMY is € 25,00. It must be transferred before the application can be processed.

PARTICIPATION COST

The participation fee is € 800,00 and consists of € 500,00 tuition and course requirements, as well as €300,00 food allowance.

Accommodation is included and free of charge (shared group accommodation). It is not possible to deselect any of the included components to receive a reduction of the participation fee.

The participation fee covers: All courses and workshops, meals (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner except on days off) and accommodation (shared group accommodation) for the entire duration of the project, as well as all fees and taxes, cost of materials (such as costumes).

What is not covered? Your personal travel costs, local transportation (such as subway, bus), private insurance/health insurance, pocket money for personal expenses (leisure).

PAYMENT METHODS

To validate your application the registration fee of € 25,00 is due together with your application.

State clearly that the payment is for WMY and include the name of the participant the payment is for.

The participation fee of € 800,00 is payable before 31 May 2014 (after you have received the acceptance agreement). For participants who moved up at a later date by a vacant space, the participation fee of €800,00 is payable within 14 days.

Please transfer your payments on our account. (use the international BIC and IBAN codes).

Important Note: bank fees are on applicant's expense. Please ask your bank beforehand whether there are fees applying with your transfer, and if so, clearly state that you wish to pay these fees and not the remittee.

Please always include the name of the participant the payment is for.

WITHDRAWAL

If you withdraw your Participation from WMY, please note the following.

A withdrawal **before acceptance agreement** is free of charge.

Cancellation after 31 May 2014: The component of food costs (€ 300,00) will be refunded. The tuition-portion (€ 500,00) will be refunded only if another participant on the waiting list is to replace you.

Cancellation after 15 June 2014: The component of food costs will be refunded, but not the tuition.

Cancellation after 30 June 2012: There will be no refunding at all.

The registration fee (€ 25,00) is refundable only if the project should be cancelled by the organizer (due to insufficient number of participants).

If you leave before the end of the program, there is no refunding of your participation fee.

→ **All fees or costs** (outgoing and incoming, sending and receiving) that incur during the transfer of money to WMY are to be paid by the debtor (the person paying). **This must usually be specified when making the payment. HEALTH ISSUES AND LIABILITY INFORMATION

Participants are required to have appropriate health and travel insurance for the period of their stay in Berlin. You may check World Escapade Travel Insurances for suitable offers: www.worldescapade.com. Event liability insurance for each participant is included in the registration fee, but this does not cover personal injury liability nor medical service or expenses. The organizer is not liable in the event of illness or injury. Participation requires a healthy physical and mental constitution. If you have any previous medical conditions that may affect your stay at or participation in WMY, they must be clearly stated on the Application Form. Each candidate must appoint two emergency contacts that can be reached in case of emergency. **We would like to mention that safety and welfare of all participants are very important for us. Volunteers will be on-campus 24h all days, providing first-aid services and quick assistance.**

TRAVELLING AND VISA

The project takes place in the city of Berlin (Germany). **It is on you to arrange your travel. This includes also the completion of any visa requirements.** It is highly recommended that you apply for Traveller's Visa at least 3 months before your arrival when applicable. We also strongly advise you to obtain information about your journey at an early stage, but to book it after receiving of the acceptance agreement only. The organizer accepts no liability in this regard for (financial) damage due to cancelation or absence of the candidate resulting from incorrect planning of her or his journey. Each participant will be sent exact travel details.

Important Note: Do not forget to ask for your **leave of absence-permission at school**, if you wish to participate outside your regular summer vacation in your country.

SCHOLARSHIP AND TRAVELLERS SUPPORT

Accepted participants (see above) are entitled to submit an application for a scholarship or for support of travel costs. **Please note:** A scholarship (or partial scholarship) or financial support to cover travel costs may become possible only through donations or grants towards WMY from third parties on a **very limited scale**. There is no entitlement to such assistance. This is how your request works:

1. We would like to ask you to first to become active yourself, and to look for own ways to raise some money for financial support – for example send a request to relevant organizations in your own country, your area or your school. There are probably more foundations, charities, etc. in your country or region who can support you financially than what you are aware of (some may be pretty obscure). Many web sites and catalogs list such institutions: Ask someone who may know where to find more information or try Googling for it. Upon written request, we will provide you with a selection of possible addresses where you may ask for such a support. If needed, you will receive a letter of confirmation by WMY which you may send along.
2. For an scholarship/traveller's support application at WMY we would ask you for a letter describing your efforts, and at least three letters of reference which prove that you have been applying to three different institutions, foundations and/or organizations with copies of their written response. If you should have received support as a result from these applications, please state the amount granted.
3. Applicants from abroad and/or from economically disadvantaged regions may receive priority when applying to WMY scholarship funds/traveller's support funds.

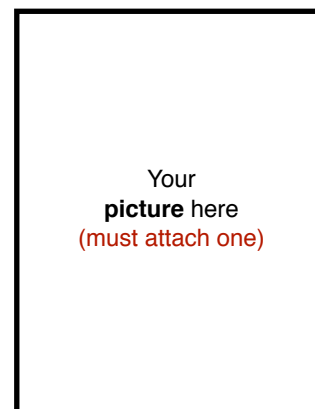
